

ADMISSION

Eligibility Criteria

Under Graduate Degree Courses

All the candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (XII Std.) conducted by the Tamil Nadu Board of Higher Secondary Education are eligible for admission into the first year of the Under Graduate Degree Course.

All the other candidates who have passed the equivalent examination conducted by other State Government/University/Board etc. are also eligible for admission not the first year of the Under Graduate Degree Course. At the time of admission, they have to produce Eligibility Certificate obtained from the University of Madras.

Women candidates will be admitted subject to their acceptance and observance of the college rules and regulations with regards to their dress and behaviour.

Post Graduate Degree Courses

The candidate who have passed B.Com., Corporate Secretaryship Degree Examination of the University of Madras (or examination of other University as equivalent thereto) are eligible for admission to M.Com. Degree Course.

Guidelines & Conditions

1. Admission can be sought by applying in the prescribed application form available in the college office.
2. The duly filled in application shall be submitted to the principal within 10 days of the publication of HSC results in person or by Post.
3. When called for interview before selection the applicants shall present the following certificates in original along with 3 sets of Xerox copies.
 - a. Transfer and conduct certificates
 - b. +2 Mark Sheet
 - c. Community Certificates
4. Fees paid after admission is not refundable under any circumstances.
5. The principal reserves the right for the admission of the applicant.
6. The applicant, when admitted, is subjected to the strict adherence and observance of the rules and regulations of the college and authorities concerned.

Note:

1. Admission of the students in all cases will be at their own risk, subject to the approval of the University of the Madras.
2. Admission is subject to verification of +2 Marks Certificate issued by the director of Government Examinations and if the mark certificate is found to be bogus, admission is liable for cancellation besides criminal actions.
