The Constitution (One Hundred and First Amendment) Act, 2016, was implemented through the One Hundred and Twenty Second Amendment Bill of the Constitution of India which brings the drastic change in fundamental of the Indian indirect-tax system by the name of GST from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2017. Thus, GST is comprehensive (included almost all the indirect taxes except a few state taxes), multistage, (imposed at every step in the production process), but is meant to be refunded to all parties in the various stages of production other than the final consumer and destination based tax (collected from point to consumption) and not point of origin like previous taxes. This tax system has completely altered India's Fiscal Federalism. The ultimate aim of the GST system is "One Nation, One Tax, One Market", which will flourish the country's Economy without any constraints and trade barriers. The aim of the workshop is to provide a platform for the participants to have proper understanding of GST in both theoretical and practical aspects.

### OBJECTIVES OF WORKSHOP

- ▶ To enrich the knowledge about the GST.
- ▶ To train the students and traders with practical application for GST returns filing.
- ▶ To provide a platform to understand the Key GST concepts.
