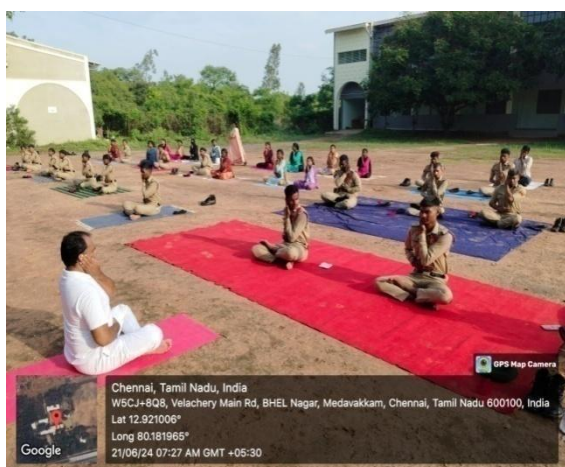
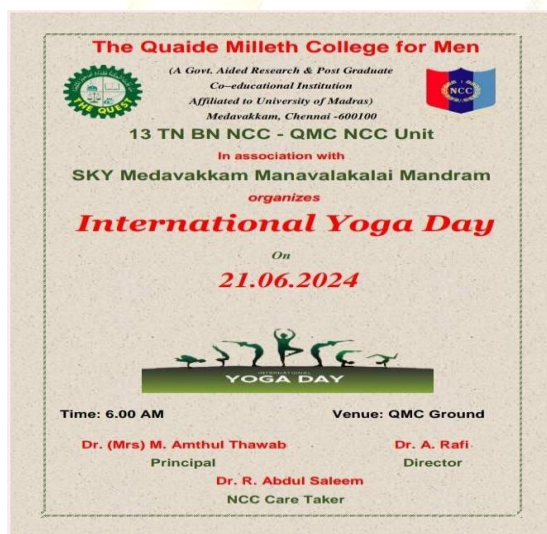




PROGRAMMES CONDUCTED FOR THE YEAR 2024 – 2025

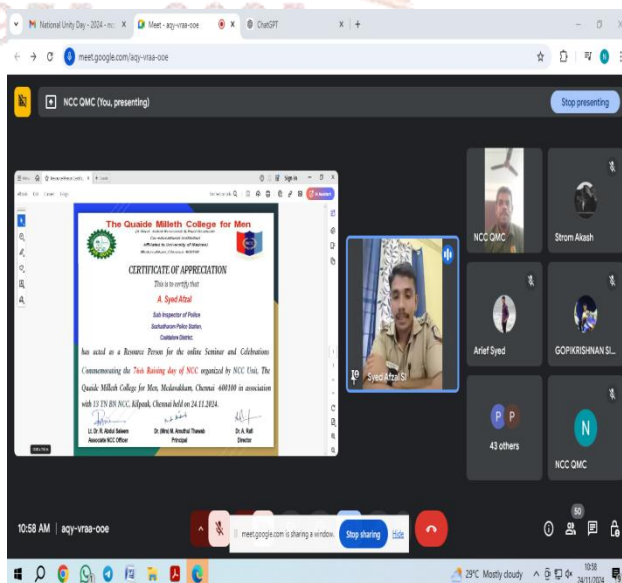
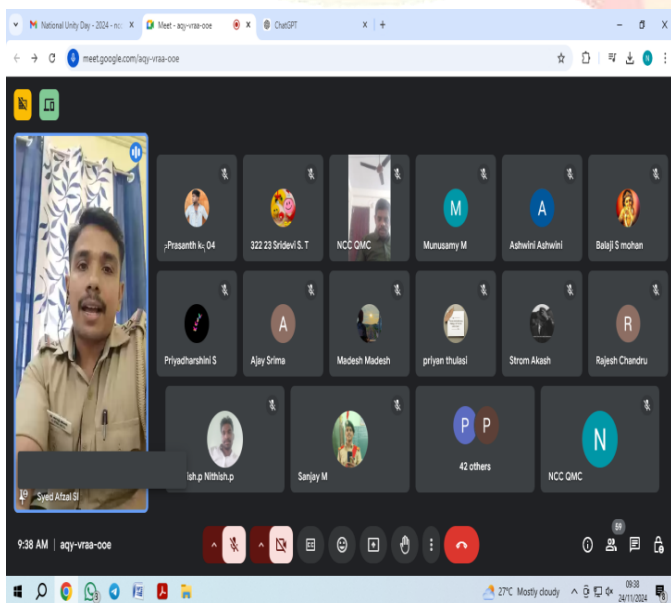
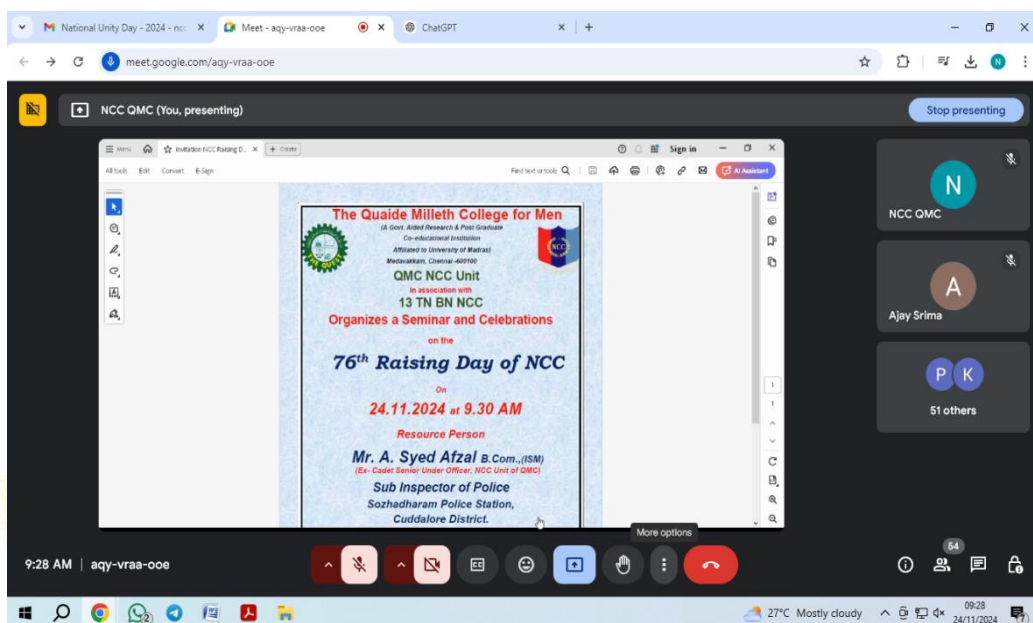

Webinar on NCC Day on 24th November 2024

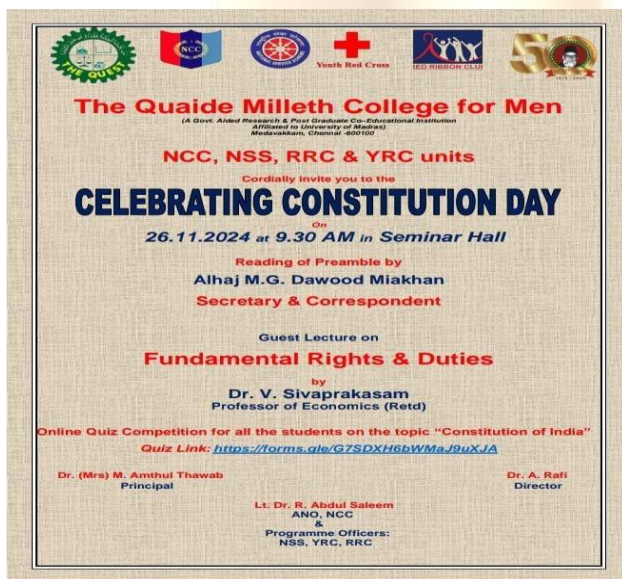

- ❖ The Quaide Milleth College for Men Celebrated Independence Day by NCC Cadets.

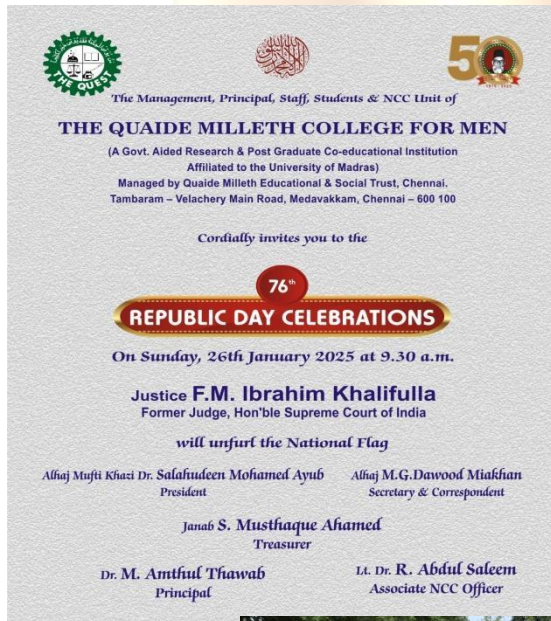

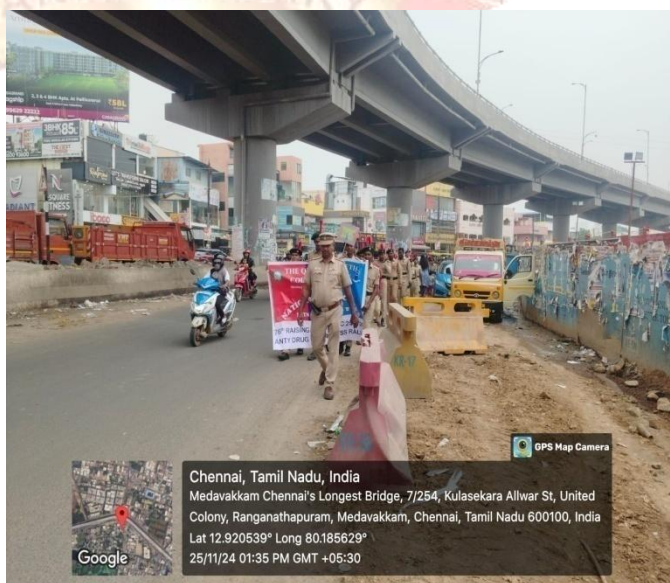
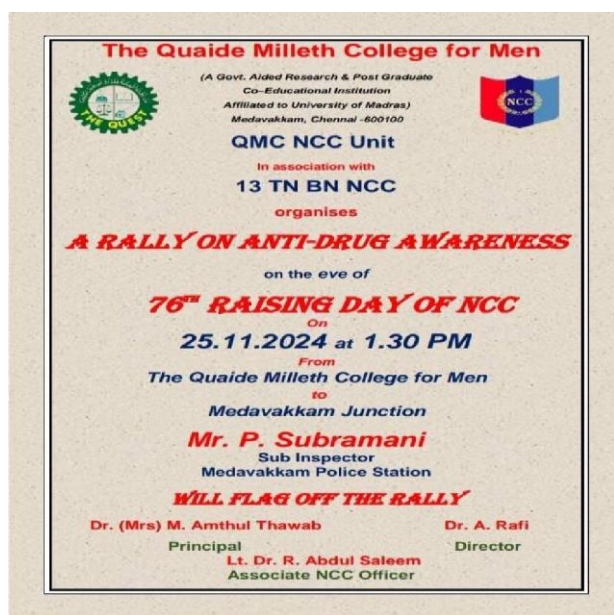
2. Anti - Drug Awareness Rally on 8/10/2024

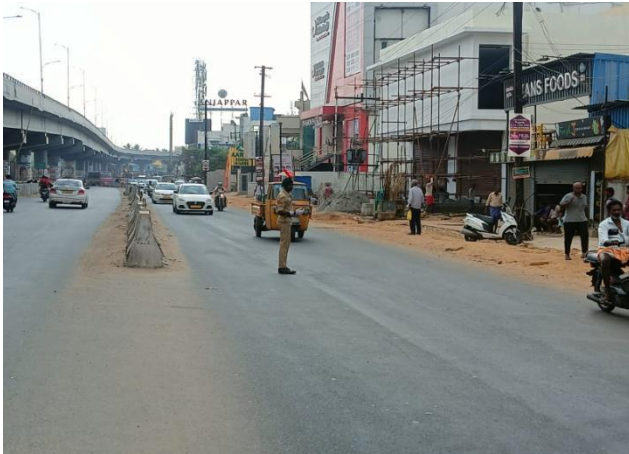
8. Anti Drug Awareness Mime On.27.02.2025

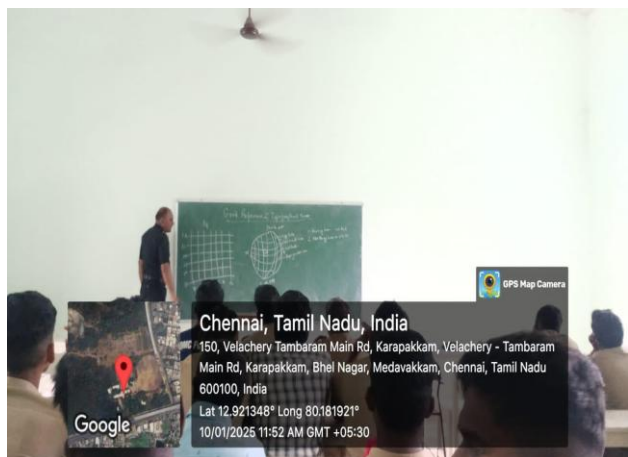
Institutional Training Parade – 2024 -2025
